Admission criteria	The MBA in International Business is structured for applicants with any Bachelor degree. OR Graduate Certificate in Business Fundamentals: Designed for students without a Bachelor degree. This serves as a direct pathway into the MBA in International Business. Fast-track (4-unit exemption): Applicants from any academic background who have at least two years of work experience at an assistant or deputy managerial level and above.
English language requirements	IELTS overall band score of 6.5 with a minimum of 6.0 in each band, or equivalent.
Course duration	16 months full-time (Fast-track delivered in 8 months) Part-time options available
Intake	February and September
Total tuition*	AED 115,500 (Fast-track option AED 77,000)
